## Social Skills Groups Now Forming in Orange County



Autism Spectrum Therapies (AST) offers structured social skills groups for children to help foster a wide range of age-appropriate social skills with direct instruction and peer-mediated strategies. Each group is facilitated by trained behavioral interventionists, using an activity-rich curriculum including role playing, arts and crafts, and games. The activities are tailored to meet the individual needs of the child. In this group setting, children improve their play, peer initiation, joint attention and conversation skills.

Several groups are offered, providing children ages 3-18 with the opportunity to grow and develop critical social skills in a fun and dynamic setting.

The group meets 2-3 times per week. Each group has no more than six children and child-to-staff ratios are low, with 2-3 children per therapist. Children are placed with other children of similar age and ability.

Children must be toilet-trained and able to communicate using basic phrases and sentences to participate.
